#### **Executive Summary**

The Department of Electronics and Communication Engineering conducted **Risky Quizness** on  $22^{nd}$  August, 2019 in Block III, Room No – 302 during 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> hour.

The First Technical Event of the odd semester proved to be a meeting ground for the first, second and third year students. 25 teams were selected on First come – First serve basis, each team comprising of maximum of 2 students.

#### **Session Content**

The unique feature of the quiz competition was that it was hosted by Somya Gupta a third year student from parent department.

The Risky Quizness event comprises of 2 rounds.

#### ROUND 1:

- The first round named **Cliché** was a pen and paper based round.
- 25 teams took part in this qualification round.
- It comprises of 20 questions which were displayed on the screen via the projector and was narrated to participants by the host.
- There were 10 '1 mark' and 10 '2 mark' questions in this round.
- Each question was given an allotted amount of time to be answered.
- This round proved to be interactive between the host and the participants.





At the end of the round the team's answer sheets were collected & evaluated. The host discussed the answers of the first round questions with the participants. After calculating the marks of all the 25 teams, the top 10 team names were announced and selected for the second round.

#### ROUND 2:

The second round named "**BID WARS**", a bidding based round was one of a kind introduced by us. The qualified participants were thrilled to hear and take part in such kind of an unique round.

- This round has 10 questions.
- These questions were displayed on the screen via the projector and were narrated by the host.
- The qualified 10 teams of this round were given 1000 points each which they could use while bidding.
- For each question the host would ask the participants to bid and the highest bidder would get to answer the question.
- Total 10 questions were displayed, bidded and answered.
- A volunteer was assigned to tally the total points of all the teams.

Because of its one of a kind bidding like round it proved to be very intriguing and an interactive session between the host and the participants. The top 3 places were announced based on the highest points earned at the end of these 10 questions.

The prizes for the top 3 teams were given by Dr.Arthi, PCA co-ordinator, from the our department.
